The figures on this table relate to “Benefit Learner” completions and their “Sustained Employment Rate”. This was published on October 27 and has been taken from Table 3: Adult (19+) Further Education Standard Outcome-Based Success Measures Provider Summary, 2013/14. The government has said: “This report, for the first time, contains sole trader returns within self-assessed employment data for tax year 2014/15 which is used to supplement PAYE data on employment rates.
